



PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Permission to rename the existing units of the Bapuji Dental College and Hospital, Davangere.

- READ: 1. G.O.No.HFW 126 MME 90, dated 19.2.1991
2. G.O.No.HFW 10 MME 91, dated 5.3.1991
3. Letter dated 31.7.1991 from the Hon.Secretary, Bapuji Educational Association, Davangere.

PREAMBLE:

In G.O.dated 19.2.1991 read at Sl.No.1 above sanction was accorded with an intake of 200 seats (110+50+40) to the First Year BDS Course for the year 1990-91 to the Bapuji Dental College, Davangere.

In G.O.dated 5.3.1991 read at Sl.No.2 above, necessary clarification was issued regarding intake of 200 seats allotted to the college which is as follows (1) Old Wing 110 seats and (2) New Building 90 seats.

The Hon.Secretary, Bapuji Educational Association, Davangere vide his letter dated 31.7.1991 read at Sl.No.3 above, has stated that they have named the new unit as 'College of Dental Sciences' and the Old Unit as in the past continuous as 'Bapuji Dental College and Hospital' and to allot 100 seats to each unit.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO.HFW 129 MME 91, BANGALORE, DATED 10TH DEC. 1991

In the circumstances explained above, sanction is hereby accorded to the allotment of 110 seats to Old Wing and 90 seats to New Building. Permission is also accorded to re-name the Old Wing as 'Bapuji Dental College and Hospital' and the New Building as 'College of Dental Sciences' with an intake of 110 and 90 seats respectively.
