Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.CODS/507/2000-2001 dated 10-05-2000 and 11-06-2000 accepting the conditions of Letter of Intent issued by this Ministry on 24-04-2000 and to convey the formal permission of the Central Govt. under Section 10 A(1) of Dentists (Amendment) Act 1993 for starting MDS course in the specialities of Oral Medicine & Radiology with 4(four) admission and (ii) Oral Pathology with 3 (three) admissions at College of Dental Sciences, Davangere with effect from 2000-2001. Further this letter of Permission is subject to the following conditions:-

1. If the admissions had been made in 1999-2000 without Central Government permission, the same will be adjusted in the year 2000-2001 and no further admissions will take place in 2000-01.
2. If the college did not admit students in 1999-2000, the Letter of Permission for 2000-01 will be valid.

This permission is granted for a period of one year i.e. for admitting one batch only and will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievements of the annual targets and revalidation of the performance bank guarantee given by you for Rs.120.00 lakhs.

The admission for 2<sup>nd</sup> batch will be made only after renewal of Permission by the Central Government. In case any admissions are made in violation of this condition, such admissions would be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Act would be initiated.
